Based upon the certifications enclosed with your letter of March 28, 1988, the EID agrees that the TA 3-102 Lithium Hydride storage area is closed in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, Section 206.C.2. Therefore, effective March 28, 1988, interim status storage, EPA code S01, is terminated. You are reminded that this area will remain subject to HWMR-4, Section 204, for less than ninety day storage if it is used for storage of hazardous waste. Please retain all records of decontamination sampling and analysis for review during the next facility compliance inspection.
