RE: Access request for VOC sampling at OU 1114, SWMU 3-010(a)

Dear Ms. Webb

AIP staff would like to gain access to the excavation pit at SWMU 3-010(a) for area sampling of residual organic vapors, specifically chlorinated constituents. The main objective of this single sampling event (approximately 6 hour sampling using a continuous air sampler) would be to obtain a qualitative assessment of any remaining volatile contaminants that may have migrated downward along the fractured tuff. The presence of a permeable unit (surge deposit) down gradient from this site was noted on a site tour on June 30, 1994, and may prove to be a viable lateral contaminant pathway.
