Dear Mr. Turner:

On September 29, 2005, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) was notified of a diesel release that occurred at TA-54-245 and TA-3-30 from a delivery truck. This spill occurred because the driver inadvertently forgot to place the gas caps on the gas tanks after he filled up the trucks tanks at Los Alamos National Laboratory, Los Alamos, New Mexico. This release was reported to NMED as required by 20.6.2.1203 NMAC of the Water Quality Control Commission. The release was approximately 3 gallons of diesel fuel.

Based on the spill response action report received on September 29, 2005, by NMED, the response was adequate and no further action is required at this time. However, this letter does not relieve The United States Department of Defense or the University of California, of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
