Subject: 3-010(a) groundwater sampling

Bob,

After perusing the January 17th sampling notification for 3-010(a), NMED is requiring that the general chemistry parameters listed in the table located in Section IX.B.2.i of the Order must be analyzed for your characterization purposes. This list includes sulfate, nitrate and many more constituents (suspended sediment concentration is not required. Since VOCs are present, NMED also requires the use of an appropriate (non-peristaltic) low-flow capable pump be used to collect the samples in order to minimize volatilization of the solvents. As a reminder, the procedures for sample collection etc. outlined in IX.B.2.i must be followed.

Please define "total organics."
