RE: NOTIFICATION OF SAMPLING EVENT IN OPERABLE UNIT (OU) 1129

Phase I field characterization will be conducted in OU 1129 at Technical Area 35 beginning the week of November 15, 1993. The primary purpose of this field characterization is to take samples from surface and shallow boreholes. These samples will be field screened for radionuclide and organic contamination, and then analyzed in detail for radionuclides, metals, and organics.

Phase I field sampling is preceded by engineering and environmental surveys. These surveys are designed to identify any potentially hazardous points within the sampling area.
