Hai and Danny,

It is our understanding that the Laboratory is planning to conduct extended pumping tests (with treatment) at monitoring wells R-28, R-42, R-43 S1, R-62, and SCI-2 starting in May or June, 2014. The Hazardous Waste Bureau has evaluated the overall benefit and technical justification for these pumping tests and cannot support such actions during this year. We do, however, support re-allocating funding from the pumping tests to the installation additional coreholes in the area of investigation with respect to optimizing path-forward objectives, including further refinement of major contaminant drip points, chromium-mass removal, and plume control within the regional aquifer.
