Two copies of map ERG-R-102 are forwarded attached. They are transmitted at request of D. K. Frosen to supplement his January 16, 1952, letter to you on the above subject.

The dumps are identified by proper location of the letters A, B, C, D, E and F. Long life alpha contamination predominates in A, B and C but is accompanied by slight amounts of beta and gamma. The same is true of D and E but a toxic element is also present to a small degree. Dump F contains some alpha contamination but is essentially used for disposal of toxic compounds.
