SUBJECT: FIELD TRIP IN TWO-MILE CANYON

On 11/10/92 Brad Wilcox and George Guthrie hiked into Two-Mile Canyon (just northeast of the concrete bowl) to locate a reported spring. Notes were taken by Brad Wilcox and are in his field notebook (#20; p. 44).

The stream in Two-Mile Canyon was not flowing; however, numerous (<10) areas of standing water were present along a several-hundred-yard section. Several (2-3) of these are associated with groves of cattails, suggesting that they were in areas of sustained moisture. The source of these wet areas may be located in an alluvial/colluvial aquifer on the southeast side of the stream (*i.e.*, on OU 1111).
