Bill,

I wish to confirm that Richard Romero and I walked the Former Structure Sites at TA-06 and identified locations of facilities and discussed placement of sample flags. Several building foundations were still visible.

For example, Building TA-06-10 where PETN was recrystallized and the boiler house, TA-06-15 along with the overgrown asphalt pad where early water recovery shots were conducted are still evident.

With help from Wilbert Meyers and Alvin Van Vessem, who worked in the area during the Manhattan Project, we used the surface landmarks as references to place building and magazine locations. I believe the locations are fairly accurately marked.

I don't believe there is any documentation on the buildings were burned in 1960.
