SUBJECT: March 9, 1999 telephone conversation with Larry Creamer on asphalt pavement around building TA-22-1, PRSs 22-012, 22-015 (d,e).

I spoke to Larry Creamer, a Group DX-1 employee at TA-22. Mr. Creamer had previously supported the ER Project as the historian for the former Operable Unit 1111 and for TA-22. In that role, he conducted numerous historical searches on TA-22. Mr. Creamer stated that to the best of his knowledge, the area around Building TA-22-1 was asphalt-paved when the HE magazines (located south of Building TA-22-1) were constructed in 1950. He also said the attached room on the southeast corner of Building TA-22-1 housed an air compressor unit. As such, he said it is very doubtful that HE compounds were handled in that attached room.

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
