SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO “UPDATED BUILDINGS OR FIXED STRUCTURES SCHEDULED TO BE DEMOLISHED DURING FIRST QUARTER 2009” LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY (LANL), EPA ID #NM0890010515 LANL-MISC

This letter provides supplemental information to ENV-RCRA-09-004, submitted by the Laboratory on January 9, 2009, and responds to your correspondence of January 26, 2009, regarding the updated list of buildings or fixed structures scheduled to be demolished during the first quarter of 2009 (January 1, 2009 through March 31, 2009). Submittal of this information is required under the provisions of the Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order (Agreement) signed April 10, 2007 between the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) and satisfies the requirements of Paragraph 21 subparagraph (e) of the Agreement.

In your January 26, 2009 letter, NMED requested notification thirty days prior to demolition of the following buildings: TA-22-20, TA-8-26, TA-8-30, TA-8-32 and TA-16-193. This letter serves as the thirty-day notification regarding the planned demolition of TA-22-20, TA-8-26, TA-8-30 and TA-16-193. Demolition of structure TA-8-32 has been postponed indefinitely and LANL requests that this building be removed from this thirty-day request of notification. LANL will report once this structure is put back on the schedule for demolition.


Additionally, in accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (f) of the Agreement, NMED has requested that LANL provide a copy of the demolition report for each of the above-named structures within thirty days after such report is written. LANL will provide copies of the demolition reports to NMED as requested if a final report for each building is written.



Regarding the last paragraph of your January 26, 2009 letter where you request Respondents submit demolition completion reports for TA-21-14 and TA-43-41 if such reports are prepared, please be advised that no demolition reports were prepared for these specific projects.
