I have marked two locations, GT Site and Sandia Canyon with X's and circles as indications of the fact that there are contaminated burial grounds there. I will be pleased to try to locate these exactly for you and by copy of this memorandum I am requesting Ted Russo to make arrangements sometime in the future to get together with this office and we will go out and see if we can determine the exact locations.

Also I would suggest that you contact Les Seely of GMX-DO and Al Van Vessem of GMX-7, to see if either of them can recollect the location of a hot burial ground that I recall in the neighborhood of the old TD Site. I am sure there was one in that vicinity.
