SUBJECT: MATERIALS DISPOSAL AREAS - REVISED DRAWING ENG-R 102, (REV. 13)

For your information and retention we are transmitting herewith Copy No. 326 of the subject map, which has been revised to include two additional disposal areas; which are identified as areas "R" and "S".

Area "R" is an old burn site located north of Passageway 16-268; extending from the passageway north to the canyon rim. The area was used as a burning ground for waste explosives prior to construction of the 132 Group buildings and the present burning area. During the course of new construction the ground surface was graded and pushed into the canyon.

Area "S" is a ten foot square area located approximately 80 feet southeast of Magazine K-36, TA-11. It is enclosed by a pipe rail and is being used for soil studies in connection with disposing of explosives in several borings within the enclosure.

Please advise this office if you are aware of any other areas where hazardous materials have been disposed of, so that we may include them on future revisions of the map; if additional copies of the revised drawing are required, please contact this office. The drawing in its present form is unclassified.
