Dear Messrs. Rael and Cantwell:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively, the Respondents) *Buildings or Fixed Structures Scheduled to be Demolished During Third Quarter 2010*, dated June 22, 2010 and referenced by ENV-RCRA-10-124/LAUR-10-04131.

In a letter dated May 3, 2010, the Permittees stated that there were decontamination and demolition (D & D) activities planned for structure TA-54-62. The structure was not included on the second quarter (dated March 24, 2010) or the third quarter lists; however, the Permittees informed NMED that structure TA-54-62 is a canopy associated with two RCRA permitted units. If that is the case, the canopy must be included with closure of the units in accordance with the Permittees' RCRA Permit.

In accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (e) of the April 10, 2007 Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order (Agreement), the Department hereby identifies Buildings TA-15-56, TA-21-31, TA-21-152, TA-21-209, TA-21-212, TA-21-357, and TA-55-7, as structures for which it requires notice of demolition. NMED requested notification of demolition activities for



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Buildings TA-21-2, TA-21-3, TA-21-4, TA-21-5, TA-21-116, TA-21-149, TA-21-150, TA-21-155, TA-21-213, TA-21-312, TA-21-313, TA-21-314, and TA-21-315 in a letter dated October 7, 2009.

The Respondents must submit a notice of commencement of demolition 30 days prior to the start of demolition for each of the above-referenced buildings. Additionally, in accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (f) of the Agreement, the Respondents must provide a copy of the demolition completion report for each building, if prepared, to NMED within 30 days following completion of the final report for each building.
