SUBJECT: FIELD UNIT 2 VCA ACTIVITIES AT TA-15

Dear Mr. Garcia:

Field Unit 2 is planning to conduct field activities at Technical Area 15 on or about June 2, 1997. A voluntary corrective action will be conducted at PRS 15-009(e). Approximately 1,000 gal. of potential liquid mixed waste will be pumped from the septic tank. After the water is removed, the septic tank will be pressure-washed. Samples will be collected from the 55-gal. drums, and if necessary, the lead will be stabilized with cement. The empty tank will be removed and disposed of. Soil samples will be collected from under the tank location and from the outfall to verify that no leakage occurred.



Samples will be collected from PRS 15-009(e) as shown in the table below.
