**SUBJECT: SCHEDULE OF DECOMMISSION AND DEMOLITION (D & D)
PROJECTS QUARTERLY REPORT FOR THE SECOND QUARTER
CALENDAR YEAR 2008**

The purpose of this letter is to submit an updated quarterly report of the list of buildings or fixed structures scheduled to be demolished for the second quarter of calendar year 2008. This correspondence is in accordance with provisions of Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order (Agreement) signed April 10, 2007 between the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), the United States Department of Energy (DOE), and Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS).

The enclosed spreadsheet lists the buildings and fixed structures currently scheduled to be demolished or undergo land transfer within the second quarter of 2008. Also, the spreadsheet identifies three land transfer projects that have had the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) accepted by DOE. All Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) landlord activities have been completed. The Real Property Release under DOE Order 5400.5a is pending. Demolition of the structures is scheduled for May 2008.

The following structures have been removed from the D&D activities list due to a loss of funding:

We understand that NMED wanted a thirty-day notification prior to D&D activities taking place for the above structures. Once funding has been identified and these buildings are again identified for D&D activities, NMED will be notified.
