NMED approves LANL's request not to jet screen 1 at intermediate well CdV-16-4ip. Note that without jetting additional swabbing at screen 1 may be needed in order to removed bentonite and other foreign material. Additional or more aggressive redevelopment actions may also increase the productive yield of screen 1 with respect to the extraction and treatment of RDX and other contaminants. This a follow up e-mail to our phone conversation this afternoon. The CdV-16-4ip work plan approval with modifications that the NMED sent requires that DOE/LANL swab, jet, and pump screen 1 after the reconfiguration is completed. Because jetting can potentially damage the filter pack, DOE/LANL recommends that we swab and bail followed by pumping to see if we can further raise the productivity of the zone without the use of jetting.
