Dear Messrs. White and Dodge:

On September 30, 2013, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received a Class 3 permit modification request (PMR) to add the Open Burning Unit at Technical Area (TA) 16-388 to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit from the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration and the Los Alamos National Security LLC, (collectively the Permittees). NMED has determined that the PMR is administratively complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee regulations, Sections 20.4.2.201.B(2) and 20.4.2.201.F, require the assessment of a fee to modify a permit when NMED makes a determination that the application is administratively complete.

Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the





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NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. James Valdez, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.


