During the spring of 1965, Ed Wilder, GMX-3, called the ENG-3 Group Office and reported that some type of metal material was thought to be buried in the old exclusion area of TA-16, which should be dug out and disposed of, provided the material could be located with some type of detector within the general area in which it was supposed to be buried. His call was in response to a request made by ENG-3 regarding information from anyone knowing of any materials disposal areas within the project which should be made a matter of record through L.J. 1757.

A survey request, dated 9/1/65, was initiated to locate several areas in S-Site vicinity, including the subject item. The survey party did the field work on 9/3/65 and located some type of metal mass, within the area they were to search, with a dip needle, marked the location with a flagged lath and notified Ed Wilder.

In a telephone conversation with Wilder the following week, it was learned that the object was dug out and was to be disposed of in the dump Area "P", situated north of the S-Site burning grounds.

Project grid coordinates of the point where the object was located are approximately S.43 / 00 and W.51 / 00.
