Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has received the Voluntary Corrective Measures Report for potential release sites (PRS) 16-006(g), 16-029(g2), C-16-074, 16-005(d), and 16-034 dated July 30, 1999, and referenced by E/ER:99-202 and found it to be Administratively Complete. A fee of \$1,750 has been assessed for review of the document based on the attached Document Review Fee worksheet.

Payment is due within sixty days of receipt of this letter.
