I was at this site today at 1320 with Jack Ellvinger (ESH-19) and Ann Sherrard (ESA). The former industrial incinerator structure TA-16-1409(? PRS number is unknown) is not present at the TA-16 burning grounds, all that remains is a concrete pad approximately 15' X 20' in size (located adjacent to the old HE basket cleaning structure). No observable contamination was present at or near the pad of this former structure, but any significant levels of residual contamination at the burning ground and remaining PRSs in the area are to be addressed under LANL's ER Project.--any questions, contact me at number listed below--Steve Yanicak
