Thanks for the call regarding the stormwater issues at the 401 and 406 sand filters. As we agreed, we will not install berms directly behind the sand filters because runoff is already covered by the TA-16 Burn Ground Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). Instead, we will continue to maintain the SWPPP stormwater controls, sample in accordance with stormwater requirements, and perform inspections to ensure that additional erosion and transport are not occurring. We will note this as a closure plan variance in the closure report. We are still intending to get the report completed June 2005.

Secondly, I would be happy to take pictures of the 406 filter for you. And please feel free to come up and take a look if you'd like. There were, fortunately, no cracks or leaks. As we discussed last June, we would like to use 401, leaving 406 empty until we want to evaluate 401 again. Then, we'll switch the sand, gravel, brick to 406, use it, and leave 401 empty until we're ready to evaluate 406 again. We will also note this as a variance in the closure report.

I would be happy to roll up everything like the berms and switching off the use of 401 and 406 in a letter so that there are no surprises when the closure report comes!!!!
