## SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF FIELD UNIT 2 GROUNDWATER SAMPLING AT TECHNICAL AREA (TA) 18

Dear Ms. Driscoll:


Field Unit 2 plans to start drilling and sampling activities at TA-18 on or about July 24, 1995, through approximately July 31, 1995.

Two groundwater wells will be installed to approximately 20 feet each and will be located adjacent to the inactive sanitary sewer line designated Potential Release Site 18-001(b). After the wells are completed, the wells will be developed and water samples will be collected. Additionally, one background well and five additional wells will also be sampled. One sample will be collected from each well. Samples will not be filtered and will be analyzed for TAL metals, volatile organic compounds, semi volatile organic compounds, total uranium, isotopic plutonium, chloride, nitrate/nitrite, and total suspended solids.

Efforts will be made to collect water samples from the interior of one or more manholes in the sewer line near the location of the wells. These samples will be analyzed for the same constituents as the groundwater samples.
