The DOE Oversight Bureau (DOE OB) has reviewed the subject document. The following comments are provided for the purpose of communicating the results of the DOE OB review. These comments are not provided or intended for the purpose of representing the regulatory position of the New Mexico Environment Department.

SWMU 18-003(e) consists of a deactivated septic tank that was filled with sand. Results from the RFI indicate the contents of the septic tank are hazardous waste. The drainfield associated with SWMU 18-003(e) contains contaminants of concern which are below SALs. Expedited Cleanup activities proposed by this plan include removing the tank contents, cleaning its interior, stabilizing the tank by filling it with concrete, and leaving it in place. After review of this report, NMED DOE OB has no recommendations to the proposed plan and no objections to its implementation.
