Dear Mr. Garcia:

Field Unit 2 is planning to conduct field activities at Technical Area (TA) 18 on or about June 9, 1997. Activities will consist of collecting surface and spring water of streams in Pajarito and Threemile Canyon and of TA -18 Spring in Threemile Canyon. Sampling will be repeated in July and August 1997 if stream flow exists.

Samples will be collected as shown in the table below.
