



SUBJECT: FIELD UNIT 2 SAMPLING ACTIVITIES AT TA-18

Dear Mr. Garcia:

Field Unit 2 is planning to conduct a Voluntary Corrective Action at Technical Area (TA) 18 on or about August 11, 1997 through approximately August 22, 1997. Activities will include excavation, removal, and downsizing for the disposal of a 100-ft long, 6-in diameter stainless steel pipe. The pipe was used from 1970-1974 to store uranium/sulfuric acid liquid reactor fuel for fission experiments. Subsurface soil samples will be collected from three locations along the length of pipe, plus other locations if field screening or visual inspection indicates soil contamination beneath pipe.

Samples will be collected as shown in the table below.
