


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

SUBJECT: CANYONS FOCUS AREA QUARTERLY SAMPLING ACTIVITIES AT TA-18, PRS 18-003(d)

Dear Mr. Garcia:

Canyons Focus Area is planning to conduct sampling activities at Technical Area 18 on or about June 24, 1998. Activities will include collecting quarterly groundwater samples from five monitoring wells. This sampling activity is being performed as part of a Corrective Action Plan Requirement. The semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOC) and target analyte list (TAL) metal analyses from five quarters of sampling have not detected concentrations of these analytes in excess of water quality standards with the exception of inorganic constituents iron and manganese. As recommended in the previous Corrective Action Status Report for this unit, SVOC and TAL metal analyses will be eliminated from future corrective action sampling and that only volatile organic compounds will be analyzed.

Samples will be collected as shown in the table below.
