The Los Alamos National Laboratory's Environmental Restoration (ER) Project is requesting a 30 day extension to respond to the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau's RSI for the VCM Plan for PRS's 18-003(a-h) (LA-UR-99-1167). The RSI was received by the ER Project Office on September 28, 1999. The extension request is a result of the need for Canyons Focus Area personnel to prioritize and expedite investigations in Acid Canyon. The VCM work for TA-18 is presently scheduled to begin in fiscal year 2003 based on prioritization under the new aggregation and watershed approach.
