This letter is intended to document outcomes of the meeting on Thursday, November 4, 1993, concerning the Technical Area (TA) 21 Phase Report 1B. As you know, the first phase report of Operable Unit (OU) 1106 was divided into two parts. Phase Report 1A was submitted to you on June 14, 1993. Phase Report 1B was due to your office in December 1993. Due to the large amount of data to report and the many aspects of the OU that needed to be covered, it was decided to obtain guidance from you on how and when to better report this information. Per your agreement with Paul Aamodt and Gary Eller of the University of California, this phase report will now be submitted in two parts. Below is the summary schedule that was agreed to:

By January 28, 1994 - Phase Report 1B will be submitted and will cover the TA-21 grid sampling analyses at 0-1 inch and 0-6 inch depth. The results of the sampling around the Filter Buildings will also be presented.

By February 28, 1994 - Phase Report 1C will be submitted and will cover the outfall sampling results.
