The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the RFI Report for Solid Waste Management Unit 21-029 at Los Alamos National Laboratory. The EPA cannot concur with the request for no further action (NFA) for this site under NFA Criterion 4 which requires the site to be remediated under another authority which adequately addresses corrective action. The site was formerly an underground fuels storage area with two fill stations. RFI data indicate that petroleum related products have been released to the environment in several locations. A certified closure statement from the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Underground Storage Tank (UST) Bureau was not submitted with this report; therefore, NFA may not be granted for the site until all corrective action activities for the NMED UST Bureau have been completed.


