RE: Extension Requests

This letter is in response to two letters dated August 11th and August 25th requesting thirty (30) day extensions to wastes being stored in the <90 day storage area at TA 21, Building 5S, ID#1423. This letter is also formal notification of the granting of the extensions.

Specifically, the waste referred to in the August 11th letter consisted of a discarded 25 gram bottle of Tetraethylammonium Perchlorate for which the 90 day expiration date would have been August 9th. Verbal approval for this extension was granted in a phone conversation before this date. The waste referred to in the August 25th letter consisted of methylphenylarsine, perflourocyclopentene, and 5,7,7,12,,14,14-hexamethyl-1,4,8,11-tetraazacyclotradeca-4,1,1-dienedidhydrobromide sodium diphenylide. No quantities were given for these wastes in storage and their 90 day expiration date was August 30th. Verbal approval was also given for the extension of storage time for these wastes.

Accordingly, the 30 day extensions will expire on September 8th and 29th respectively. If there are any questions regarding this letter, please contact me at 827-1558.
