The Underground Storage Tank Bureau (USTB) of the New Mexico Environment Department has reviewed the letter dated August 9, 1999, regarding a Request for Supplemental Information for the 21-029 site. The USTB, in response to general comment number 4 on page 2 of the attachment, is referring this site to the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB).

Since hazardous and radioactive constituents have been identified at the site, and this facility is permitted as a solid waste management unit, the USTB refers the site known as 21-029 (DP Tank Farm) to HRMB and requests that the HRMB regulate all further corrective action at the site. Corrective action for the petroleum hydrocarbons at the site must fulfill the requirements of the New Mexico Underground Storage Tank regulations outlined in 20NMAC5.

The USTB will be available for review and consultation to the HRMB in matters relating to the petroleum hydrocarbon contamination. Please send a copy of all correspondence regarding the corrective action at this site to the Remediation Program Manager of the USTB.
