Discussion: During a site visit to DP Tank Farm earlier this morning, Jayne Jones and I reported to Vicki Maranville of NMED-HRMB that the offsite analytical laboratory had left six sediment samples collected during the ongoing DP Tank Farm RFI out at room temperature for 12 days from the time of receipt at the lab. The six sediment samples include 3 from the drainage channel: samples MD21-00-0035, 0036 and 0037, and 3 collected beneath each storm drain: samples MD21-00-0079, 0080, and 0081. The samples were to be analyzed for TPH-ethanol. Vicki agreed that we do not need to resample these locations since ethanol was not expected to be present in surface sediment samples. Additionally, if it's present, the TPH as ethanol will be detected in samples collected from the auger holes in and around the hydrocarbon seep area.
