>Thanks for taking the time to meet with me and give me a site tour of
>TA-21-57. As promised, the following is a summary of our TA-21-57 meeting
>and subsequent site visit.

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>Proposed additional characterization of the site was discussed. Based on
>the information provided (three figures and a written summary), NMED HWB
>agrees with the proposed additional investigation approach.

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>All proposed borehole locations are acceptable. Boreholes are proposed to a
>total depth (TD) of 155 feet below ground surface (bgs) or 10 feet below
>contamination encountered during drilling, whichever is greater.

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>Proposed additional characterization activities will be conducted in
>accordance with the NMED letter dated May 28, 2003 and titled, "Response and
>Comments for Diesel Spill Located at Technical Area 21-57." Specifically
>discussed was the use of TPH screening levels. Soil screening must be
>conducted in accordance with NMED soil screening guidelines for TPH, dated
>February 28, 2003. All boreholes must be completed to a minimum depth of
>145 feet bgs, if TPH concentrations exceed 880 mg/kg the boring must be
>installed until TPH as diesel are below the NMED soil screening guidelines.

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>An addendum to the SAP will be submitted to NMED for review and approval on
>or before August 29, 2003.

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>NMED and LANL representatives, at the direction of DOE OB, located a
>hydrocarbon stained area on the mesa top adjacent to TA 21-57. Based on the
>site visit, it is unclear if the surface staining observed is related to TA
>21-57. LANL will look into the staining area further and provide
>information to NMED.

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>Please review the above summary, and if it is corrected please reply to this
>email. If corrections or clarification are needed, please let me know so I
>can finalize this summary and copy it for the NMED Administrative Record.
