In response to your email regarding the use of SALs, NMED has the following comment;

NMED reminds the Permittees that according to a letter from Mr. Everet Beckner, Deputy Administrator for Defense Programs for the Department of Energy (DOE), dated August 26, 2004, the Permittees committed to voluntarily provide "the total dose for radionuclides of potential concern and the equivalent total radionuclide risk level for each site that is subject of an environmental investigation." In addition to SALs derived from RESRAD per DOE guidance to calculate total dose, NMED requests the Permittees voluntarily calculate total radiation risk using the EPA Radiation Risk Assessment Guidance for Superfund (RAGS) (January 1998), in accordance with Section VIII.B.1 of the March 1, 2005 Consent Order.
