Activities: A Class 3 permit modification has been requested to remove Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) from Table A of Module VIII in the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit.

Facility: Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) is owned by the National Nuclear Security Administration of the Department of Energy (NNSA-DOE), and is operated jointly by NNSA-DOE and the University of California. Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (Section 74-4-1 et seq., NMSA 1978, as amended, 1992) and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC), the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) can approve or deny hazardous waste permits and closure plans, permit modifications, and amendments.

Modifications: LANL has requested a Class 3 permit modification removing three SWMUs from Table A of Module VIII because they have been approved for no further action (NFA) by the NMED. The following SWMUs are approved for NFA because they were characterized and/or remediated in accordance with current applicable state or federal regulations:

- SWMU 21-013(d) Construction and Building Debris
- SWMU 21-013(e) Construction and Building Debris
- SWMU 21-024(f) Septic System

Meeting: The public is invited to attend an additional informal informational meeting scheduled on September 13, 2005, from 6 to 7:30 pm at the Trinity on the Hill Episcopal Church, 3900 Trinity Drive, Los Alamos NM. This meeting will present the same information regarding the permit modification as presented in Pojoaque, NM, the evening of August 25, 2005. NNSA-DOE and LANL staff members will be available at the meeting to provide information on the proposed modification.

Comment: Any person who would like to comment or would like to request a public hearing on the proposed Class 3 permit modification may do so by contacting: John E. Kieling, Program Manager, at the NMED-Hazardous Waste Bureau address listed above, via telephone (505) 428-2500, or via e-mail: john.kieling@state.nm.us. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from the NMED contact person. Requests for a hearing shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing and must include the requestor's name and address. The 60-day public comment period for this permit modification begins on August 29, 2005, and ends on October 28, 2005. This period has been extended from the originally referenced August 10, 2005 start date. Any person who wishes to comment on this action or request a public hearing should submit written or e-mail comments with the commenter's name and address to the address above. Only comments and/or requests received by October 28, 2005, will be considered.
