Katie—

As we discussed earlier this afternoon, I would like to propose some changes to the appendices shown in the currently approved outline for the SWMU 21-018(a)-99 investigation report (LANL letter dated 2005). Appendix F is currently listed as a Field Summary Report, which is a rather large internal document containing field forms, copies of field logs, etc. Some of this information, such as chain-of-custody forms, is already provided in the electronic data packages that are part of Appendix E. I would like to eliminate the Field Summary Report and instead produce a Data Review Appendix, which goes over COPC identification, nature and extent of contamination, etc. I think this data review will be much more meaningful to the discussion in the main body of the text.

If you still think you might want a copy of the Field Summary Report for SWMU 21-018(a)-99, I would be happy to provide that to you under separate cover once it is available.
