Mitch and Bill,

James returned from vacation yesterday and has not had a chance to review the NOD. We hope to send it out by the end of next week.

It was NMED's understanding that the sampling at the bottom of the excavation was part of the investigation/remediation work plan. The subsequent SAP will only be for borehole locations and sampling intervals, which will be based in part on the analytical results of the sampling from the bottom of the excavation. Therefore, Table 4.10-1 must remain in this Plan.

As stated in our draft comments (Section 4.14 Borehole Sampling Activities, page 17, paragraph 1), LANL shall remove all references to specific numbers of boreholes and/or samples in all applicable sections. Sections 5.6, 5.7, and 5.9 will remain in this Plan and be subject to public comment. These sections will not be required in the subsequent SAP if they are officially approved by NMED in this Plan.
