Katie, this e-mail serves to document our conversation today regarding the October 2006 NMED TPH screening guidelines. Since the submission of the Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) in November 2005, NMED has revised the TPH screening guidelines. Per the approved SAP we will continue to use the 880 ppm screening level to determine the total depth of the boreholes presented in the SAP. If at the total proposed depth of 175 feet we are not below 880 ppm or we see an increasing trend we will continue to drill and sample until we achieve that screening level and have a decreasing trend. I will keep you posted on our progress. Thanks for getting back to me so quickly with your review of the guidance.
