Bruce,

NMED confirms LANL's interpretation of what must be included in the *4th Quarter Periodic Vapor-Monitoring Report for MDA T*. NMED acknowledges that the North Perimeter borehole is not yet complete and therefore 4 quarters of data will not be available for incorporation in the stip deliverable. As stated in the May 26, 2009 letter, "[on]ce the new monitoring wells are complete, they must be added to the existing quarterly vapor sampling program. Based on the Permittees' current quarterly sampling schedule (March, June, September, December), the Vapor Monitoring Reports for MDA T vapor sampling must be submitted to NMED within 120 days after completion of field work in July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 (*already submitted*), October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009 January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010."

Katie,

We would like confirmation on the scope for the MDA T stipulated penalty deliverable. The 2010 MDA T stip deliverable, due to NMED 4/30/2010 (entitled *4th Quarter Periodic Vapor-Monitoring Report for MDA T*), could imply that four quarters of vapor data will be required for vapor monitoring well 21-25262 as well as vapor monitoring well 21-607955 on North Perimeter Road (installation is in process and not yet completed). We believe the deliverable should include 4 quarters of vapor data for 21-25262 (and 3 other existing vapor wells) and only one quarter of vapor data from 21-607955. This reflects the estimated start dates in Table 1 of the approved MDA T Phase III Work Plan.


