**Subject: Notice of Demolition, Los Alamos National Laboratory Delta Prime Site, Building 21-155**


Dear Mr. Bearzi:

Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory) is planning to initiate structural demolition of Delta Prime Site buildings 21-155 on or after March 31, 2010. This notice of demolition is in response to the above-referenced letter and in accordance with the Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order (Settlement Agreement) signed on April 10, 2007.

As discussed in the January 26, 2009, telephone conversation between Jack Ellvinger and Kathryn Roberts, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) had previously requested notice under the Settlement Agreement on Delta Prime Site Building 21-220. Delta Prime Site Building 21-220 was included in the NMED's October 7, 2009, request for notice. The Laboratory responded on November 12, 2009, stating that Delta Prime Site Building 21-220 would be demolished on or after December 12, 2009. Ms. Roberts checked her records and agreed that the Laboratory had already met the notice requirement for Delta Prime Site Building 21-220. Mr. Ellvinger also informed Ms. Roberts that the demolition of Delta Prime Site Building 21-220 had begun on January 25, 2009.

Two other buildings, Delta Prime Site Buildings 21-213 and 21-420, were included in NMED's October 7, 2009, request for notice and the Laboratory's November 12, 2009, response. The demolition of Delta Prime Site 21-420 also began on January 25, 2009. The Laboratory is planning to demolish Delta Prime Site Building 21-213 concurrently with the demolition of Building 21-155.

With respect to your request for copies of final demolition reports for each building, the Settlement Agreement does not require the Laboratory to generate building-specific demolition reports. Upon completion of additional project milestones, a Technical Area 21 (TA-21) comprehensive report will be prepared, if required, and a copy will be sent to NMED, within 30 days of completion. The report will be completed before October 2011.



Additionally, as discussed between Jack Ellvinger and Katie Roberts on the afternoon of October 27, 2009, the Laboratory has been expediting demolition of buildings at TA-21 based on current funding levels.


