Katie, we have removed most of the asphalt from the surface of MDA B (should be done today). The large movable enclosures (there are 2 of them) require a good surface to be moved on (they go on areas 4 & 6). We had planned to bring in new base course, but it would save us time & money (and we wouldn't create new waste) if we could reuse some of the asphalt instead. In its original condition (i.e., before we remove it) it is in too poor of a condition to use a base, but if we crush it, place it and compact it, it'll work. It never leaves the current AOC. Following its use, we'll sample appropriately & dispose of it as waste. Thoughts?
