Katie, we have received NMED's approval of the extension request and appreciate NMED's understanding of the magnitude of the changes we will be making to the DP Site Aggregate Area Phase II Investigation Report. We are completing examples of the addition of TD to the figures and will get you revised figures for review early next week. We are also working with ADEP to get the programmatic changes to the figures and ecological screening instituted as quickly as possible. At the clarification meeting on July 14, 2010 we discussed potentially moving The All Analyses tables to be co-located with the analytical tables for each site. Because this change would require changing all the callouts within the report and appendices we are requesting to institute this change on all future reports, if that is acceptable to NMED.
