The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security, L.L.C.'s (collectively, the Permittees) document entitled *Clarification of Submittal Schedule for the Corrective Measures Implementation Plan and Remedy Completion Report for Material Disposal Area T* dated December 10, 2013 and referenced by EP2013-0320.

The Permittees seek clarification on the submittal schedule for the Corrective Measures Implementation Plan (CMI) and Remedy Completion Report (RCR) for Material Disposal Area (MDA) T. In a letter dated June 11, 2012, NMED approved an extension request from the Permittees for the submittal of the Corrective Measures Evaluation (CME) Report. The date for submittal of the CME Report was moved from December 11, 2012 to December 11, 2014.

Based on Sections VII.E.2 and VII.E.6 of the Compliance Order on Consent, the submittal of the CMI is contingent on NMED's selection of a remedy and the submittal of the RCR is contingent

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


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on the Permittees' completion of the remedy. Therefore, NMED agrees that the Permittees will extend the submittal date for the MDA T CMI to a date corresponding to a timeframe determined by the remedy selection. In addition, NMED agrees that any extension of the submittal date for a CME Report approved by NMED will also extend the subsequent corrective action documents (i.e., CMI, RCR).
