





**SUBJECT: SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES AND QUESTIONS REGARDING
NEW SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT UNITS (SWMUs) 32-003
AND 32-004, AND AREA OF CONCERN (AOC) C-61-002**

Dear Mr. Neleigh:

This letter is in response to your letter dated September 25, 1995, regarding the new SWMU notification for 32-003 and 32-004 and new AOC notification for C-61-002.

As you have specified, SWMUs 32-003 and 32-004 will be added to Module VIII of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit via a Class I permit modification. On June 30, 1995, a sampling plan for the investigation of these units was submitted to your office for review as part of the RCRA facility report for technical area 32. The Los Alamos National Laboratory is currently in the process of developing a site ranking value for SWMUs 32-003 and 32-004, but because both units are located immediately adjacent to the Los Alamos townsite, they are considered a high priority for investigation. Therefore, the schedule of corrective action for the units has been loaded into the Fiscal Year (FY) 1996 baseline and it begins with initiation of the sampling plan early in the year. The investigation is scheduled to be completed in FY96, if current project funding levels are not altered significantly.

You have also requested that you receive any information that becomes available for C-61-002, an oil spill from fuel flare pots. Because of its lower priority and the limited amount of funding available to cover newly identified low risk sites, an investigation for this unit has not currently been included in the baseline. When funds become available, a sampling plan and corrective action schedule will be developed. We anticipate this to be at least several years from this time.






