Within the next two months M-Division will probably place a formal request for the construction of a shaft and chamber similar to that at TA-33. The location will be near that site. Some modifications of the plans are now under consideration and the formal request will be held up until these matters are settled.

It probably would be advisable to notify A.E.C. Operations that such further construction is under consideration. Eventually we will probably want a total of three such shaft-chamber installations. We should like to have some estimate on the cost of making these one at a time, as compared with the construction of three units under a single contract. There are always the possibilities either that not all installations will be used or that changes in procedure will require modification of the facilities. We would therefore prefer to order one unit at a time, unless there is a substantial saving in multiple construction.

Only one unit will be used at a time and it is proposed that the same elevator house, elevator cage, headquarters building and warehouse be used for the three operations.
