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- 1. We have spoken to Dr. Whipple about proposed location of new shaft (175-200 ft. nearer to control bldg., along the line of cables.)
- 2. Dr. Whipple's suggestion is that as the shaft is dug samples of rock be examined for radioactivity at vertical intervals of approximately 8 feet and also at such times when a new layer of rock is reached. It is important to closely observe the progress of the work in order to promptly detect any fissures in the rock which may be a path for contamination.
