Gentlemen:

1. In reference to your four letters to us dated August 20th regarding the subject job, you have our permission to waive the following requirements of the Non-Technical Provisions of the specifications:

- a. Paragraph 3a. Shop drawings for reinforcing steel and other miscellaneous iron work, including the heavy door and frame required for the chamber.
- b. Paragraphs 3b and 3c. Samples, descriptive data, and tests (with the exception that we will take cylinders of each concrete pour for destructive testing)
- c. Paragraph 5a. Progress charts, procurement schedules, etc.

2. All equipment to be furnished by the Government, as listed in Paragraph 3f of the Non-Technical Provisions, will be delivered to the construction site. We expect to have everything necessary at the site well before the time you are ready for installation.

3. We do not desire that you make any repairs to the existing elevator building or do any work at the site, other than that called for by contract as noted in the drawings and specifications.

4. Confirming your conversation with Mr. Williams regarding the door for the chamber, this piece of equipment is to be of the same construction as that installed by you last winter in Chamber No. 1, TA-33, except that the hinge design has been changed and the door swing reversed.
