RESULTS OF MONITORING THE EXPERIMENT OF T. A. 33 ON DECEMBER 23, 1948.

REFERENCE: LAB-H-1

The experiment of T. A. 33 was detonated at 9:00 P. M. on December 23, 1948. No earth tremor or explosion what-so-ever was apparent from the trailer position. On driving to the covered-in shaft, no cracks in the ground could be found. The entire area over the shaft was checked with an Alpha survey meter. The results were negative.

The area was rechecked on December 29, 1948. Results were again negative. Snow and mud hampered a complete survey on this date.
