SPECIAL T. A. 33 EXPERIMENT ON DECEMBER 6, 1949.

The W-3 group performed a special experiment at T. A. 33 on December 6, 1949, under the direction of Commander James Dare and D. P. MacMillan. The experiment was the same as one mentioned in a memo to you from Carl Buckland dated November 14, 1949.

Scott Air Packs and rubber gloves were worn during monitoring operations. This time the assembly remained intact and no counts were found on the assembly. Personnel were cautioned about entering the smoke area wearing only respirators. Personnel were very cooperative and left the control room, and walked around outside the building, and remained clear of the smoke area.

After the experiment personnel were checked for stray contamination and no counts were found.
